

Island Transit: General Information

Dial-A-Ride

For individuals who qualify for services under the Americans with Disabilities Act, and cannot access the fixed route buses, Island Transit offers Dial a Ride Transit. To obtain information regarding this service, please call 409-797-3909. Cost per trip is \$1.00 each way.

Passes/Tokens

Tokens/Passes and tokens offer convenience and economy. Passes are good for unlimited rides during the calendar month. Tokens are available in packages of 10. Both may be purchased at Island Transit, 3115 Market Street and also at City Hall, 823 Rosenberg. Must show the Monthly Pass each time you board the Bus.

Boarding & Deboarding

Buses stop only at bus stop signs and intersections. Please help us operate on schedule by exiting through the rear door whenever possible.

To make transit rides as pleasant, clean, and comfortable as possible for all riders, please:

ID Cards

ID Cards are available for seniors over 65 years of age and disabled citizens. A US Medicare card may also be used as proof of age or disability. These forms of ID entitle customers to discounted fares. Written proof of age or disability is required to obtain the Island Transit ID. There is a fee of \$3.00. ID cards may be obtained at 3115 Market Street. Office hours are Monday-Friday from 8:00AM to 5:00PM excluding holidays. Must show Island Transit ID and or Medicare Card each time you board the Bus.

Bike & Ride

Island Transit has installed bike racks on buses and is now able to provide a much needed service in the Galveston area. The Bike & Ride service is convenient and easy to use. Customers are responsible for loading and unloading their own bicycles as well as removing any loose objects. No additional fare will be required for this service. Following the simple safety rules will ensure efficient and safe service for our passengers and their bicycles.
